Nominations

The Nominating Committee has selected the following candidates for re-election on the 2026 Ballot:

Jeff Coffman, Incumbent - Jeff has served as volunteer since 2008 in various capacities, including Board Chair for eight years. Jeff has recently retired as the School Resource Officer for the Crook County School District after serving 36 years with the Prineville Police Department.

Official Election Notice of Petition

Any qualified member who wishes to be a Director candidate may submit a written petition for nomination signed by at least five hundred (500) Oregonians members, mailed to the Nominating Committee at 6915 SE Lake Rd, Milwaukie, OR 97267, on or before **April 9, 2026**.

To qualify to serve as a Director, you must:

1. Be an Oregonians member age 18 or older.
2. Agree to and comply with the Oregonians Code of Ethics Policy.
3. Not have been employed by Oregonians or any subsidiary during the past two years, or have any immediate family members who are paid employees of Oregonians.

Election Ballot

Candidates approved by either the Nominating Committee or by submitting a valid petition will be placed on the election ballot. All members of Oregonians age 18+ and in good standing can visit any Oregonians branch to vote. Election results will be announced at the Annual Meeting on May 19, 2026. There will be no nominations from the floor, and no election ballot will be conducted if the number of nominees equals the number of positions to be filled.
